## From Rabbi Krauss



Let me tell you about Purim, Frankfurt and Jews. The city of Frankfurt is one of the few places in Western Europe that had a Jewish Community almost without interruption since the 12th century. The Frankfurt community had unique customs, melodies and food. I was able to experience the beautiful Torah Trope, the delicious food and highly intelligent conversation in Washington Heights, New York where many Frankfurt Jews settled. (Why almost) It was in 1614 when the anti-Semite Vincent Fettmilch who called himself the new Haman led a pogrom into Frankfurt's Ghetto. The Jews valiantly tried to defend themselves, but were expelled from the city. By 1616 the emperor ordered the arrest of Fettmilch and had him hanged. The Jews returned to Frankfurt that year. As a result, the Jews of Frankfurt began observing a second Purim on the 20th of Adar called Purim Winz. (Vincent). Megillat Winz was chanted. Of course, this was before the Holocaust. Jewish communities throughout the world celebrated Special Purims recalling historical redemptions.

Frankfurt was the home of distinguished Jewish personalities who have influenced our Jewish world. Among many others, Rabbi Samson Hirsch, Franz Rosenzweig, and Martin Buber. Somewhat more than half of Frankfurt Jews left Germany. About 10,000 did not survive.

Today about 6,000 Jews live in Frankfurt. Its mayor is Jewish, Peter Feldmann.

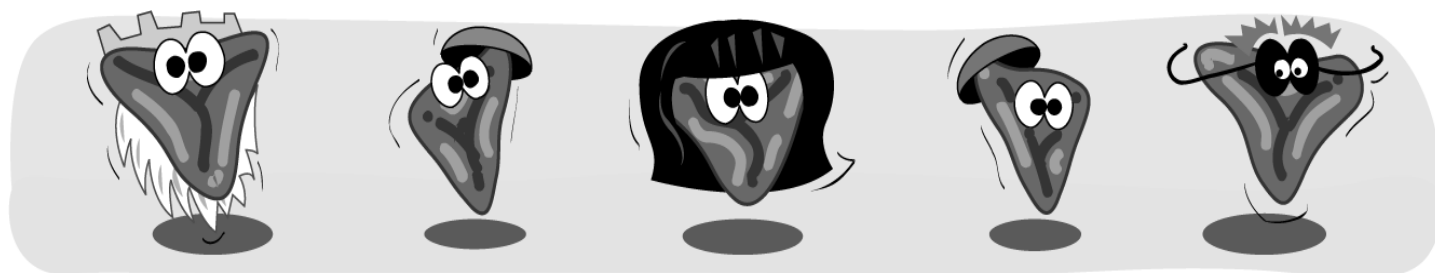

## ***Mechirat Chametz – SALE OF CHAMETZ***

### **PROHIBITION OF CHAMETZ ON PESACH**

On Pesach it is prohibited to possess chametz (leaven). All chametz that will not be eaten or burned before the morning of April 8.

Pesach must be sold to a non-Jew. All chametz utensils that will not be thoroughly cleaned by then, and are stored away in closets or rooms while preparing for Pesach. The storage area is locked or tape-shut, and leased to a non-Jew at the time of the sale.

There are many legal intricacies in this sale, thus, only a competent rabbi should be entrusted with its execution. The rabbi acts as our agent both to sell the chametz to the non-Jew on the morning before Pesach starts and also to buy it back the evening after Pesach ends which is Thursday, April 16 after sundown.

Rabbi Krauss the Signed Chametz Contract is an easy way of observing one of the most important laws in the Torah. Chametz which remains in the possession of a Jew over Pesach may not be used, eaten, bought or sold even after Pesach.

### **DELEGATION OF POWER FOR SALE OF CHAMETZ**

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Chaim Block to act in my place and stead, and on my behalf to sell all Chametz possessed by me, knowingly or unknowingly as defined by the Torah and Rabbinic Law (e.g. Chametz, possible Chametz, and all kinds of Chametz mixtures).

Also Chametz that tends to harden and adhere to inside surfaces of pans, pots, or cooking utensils, the utensils themselves, and all kinds of live animals and pets that have been eating Chametz and mixtures thereof.

Rabbi Krauss is also empowered to lease all places wherein the Chametz owned by me may be found, particularly at the address/es listed below, and elsewhere.

Rabbi Krauss has full right to appoint any agent or substitute in his stead and said substitute shall have full right to sell and lease as provided herein.

Rabbi Krauss also has the full power and right to act as he deems fit and proper in accordance with all the details of the Bill of Sale used in the transaction to sell all my Chametz, Chametz mixtures, etc., as provided herein.

**This power is in conformity with all Torah, Rabbinic and Civil laws.**

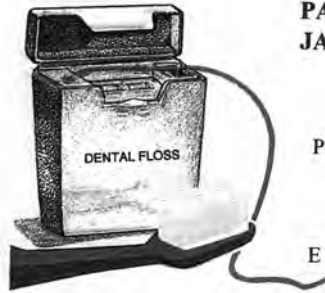
