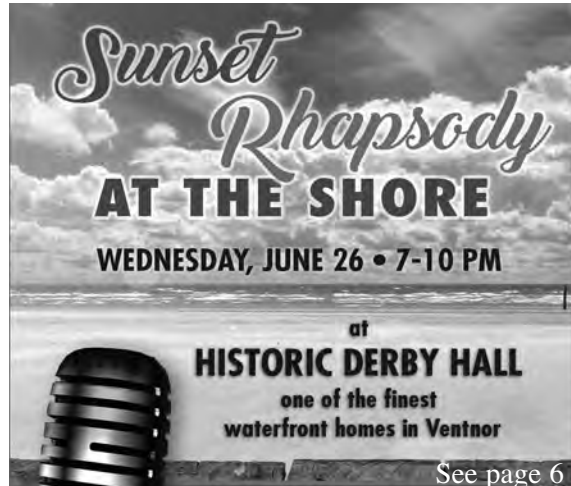

## From Rabbi Krauss



A burning question on the world stage is whether anti-Zionism is equivalent to anti-Semitism. How can we distinguish between legitimate criticism of the policies of the Israeli government and outright Jew-hatred. Just as reasonable citizens speak up regarding their countries actions and those of other countries, so Israel is not immune in that regard.

A striking example of crossing a red line is the exculpatory suggestion by some Europeans is the drawing of a parallel between Nazi treatment of Jews and Israeli treatment of Palestinians. That is flagrant anti-Semitism.

In a debate on this issue between Peter Beinart in the Forward and Zeyba Mar in the American Thinker, in a key phrase Beinart opines Jewish leaders who call for national self-determination as a universal right are quite comfortable in denying it to Palestinians. Beinart takes the position that anti-Zionism is not anti-Semitism. Beinart further argues that Satmor Haidim who are vigorously anti-Zionist are not anti-Semitic.

Zeyba Mur writing in the American Thinker takes the opposite position. Israel, she argues, have at various crucial times offered the Palestinians opportunities to establish their state under favorable conditions, The Palestinians rejected the offers preferring to wait for the opportunity to end Israel's existence. Regarding the Satmer, Murargus that the Satmar do believe in the ultimate Jewish return to the Promised Land albeit after the arrival of the Messiah. So they are Zionists in a millennial sense after all.

Speaking as a lifelong strong Zionist, anti-Zionism is not always anti-Semitism. But in full agreement with world leaders such as Emmanuel Maeron, President of France and Secretary of State Pompous, anti-Zionism is used all too often as a form of anti-Semitism.

# HAZZAN NOTES



After Pesach we move into a variety of special days in May and June! April 30 is *Yom HaShoah*, Holocaust Remembrance Day. There'll be a special community service at Shirat Hayam that evening. Please come and represent Beth El with significant numbers. More information will be forthcoming. In Israel a siren sounds midday to remember the Six Million victims. Everything stops for those moments. People stop working, traffic stops and people get out of their cars. Everyone is quiet and stands in solemn commemoration. May 8 is *Yom HaZikaron* where we remember the fallen soldiers and victims of terrorism in the State of Israel. A special siren again sounds midday in Israel and the country again comes to a halt. In the evening after *Yom HaZikaron* is complete, Israel parties as the day morphs into *Yom HaAtsmaut* – Israel Independence Day which goes thru the 9th. In our community there will be a special event in the evening of the 9th for *Yom HaAtsmaut*. More information will be forthcoming. The countdown is on towards *Shavuot*, the Feast of Weeks connecting *Pesach* with the Giving of the 10 Commandments at Mount Sinai. This is one of the three *Shalosh Regalim*, the Pilgrimage Holidays. It's called Pilgrimage because in the days of the Holy Temple people from all over the land of Israel would bring a large portion of their farm goods to the Temple in Jerusalem. For us it's a celebration of the Giving of the Law. We have two days of *Yom Tov* on June 9 and 10. *Yizkor* will be approximately 10:30 a.m. on the 10th. We eat Dairy because traditionally when the laws of *Kashrut* were given at Sinai, there wasn't enough time to decipher the laws concerning meat so the Israelites ate dairy. Another theory states that the giving of the law was so profound that no killing should take place, even the slaughter of animals. While two of the days mentioned are solemn, the other days are festive, so enjoy the season as we move closer to summer!

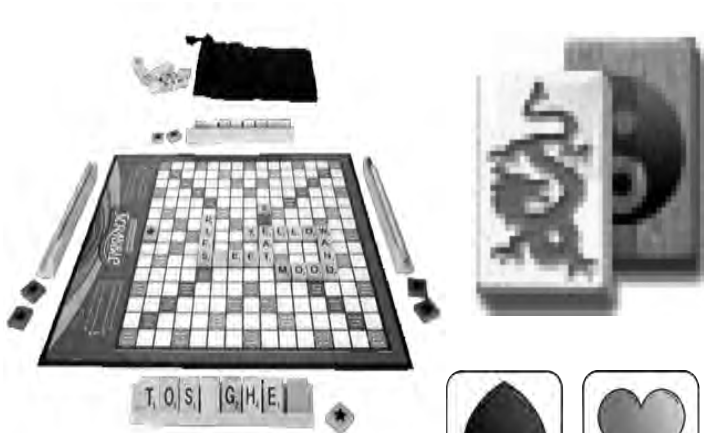

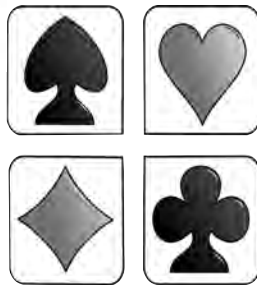

## Shavuot Pentecost Feast of Weeks

Shavuot the "Feast of Weeks," is celebrated seven weeks after Passover (Pesach). Since the counting of this period (sefirat ha-omer) begins on the second evening of Passover, Shavuot takes place exactly 50 days after the (first) seder.

Hence, following the Greek word for "fifty," Shavuot is also referred to sometimes as Pentecost. Although its origins are to be found in an ancient grain harvest festival, Shavuot has long been identified with the giving of the Torah.

Shavuot combines two major religious observances. First is the grain harvest of the early summer. Second is the giving of the Torah on Mount Sinai seven weeks after the exodus from Egypt. The first determines the ritual for the holiday, which was one of the three pilgrimage festivals of ancient Israel, when Israelite males were commanded to appear before God in Jerusalem, bringing offerings of the first fruits of their harvest. The second determines the significance of the holiday for Judaism, tying it in with the seminal event of Jewish religious memory, namely the entering into a covenant between God and Israel, exemplified by Israel's assumption of Divine law.

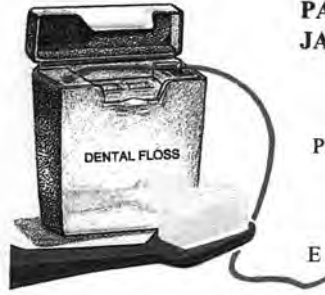

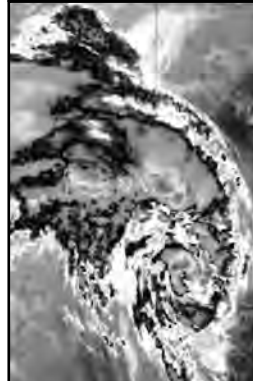
